### **Are The Mennonite and Mennonite World Review merging?**

The Mennonite, Inc., and Mennonite World Review, Inc., are merging to form a new independent media organization with a vision for a flagship Anabaptist communications hub in print and online. We will have a new name, a new magazine and a new website.

### **What happens to my subscription to The Mennonite between now and 2020?**

Everyone with time left on their subscription to The Mennonite will have that time added on to your subscription of the new magazine that will begin publishing in September 2020. For those who subscribe to The Mennonite and Mennonite World Review, your remaining time will be combined and added to your new subscription. For example, in September 2020 if you have two months remaining on your subscription to The Mennonite, your subscription to the new magazine will begin with two months before renewal time. In another example, if you have two months remaining on your subscription to The Mennonite, and you have three months remaining on your subscription to Mennonite World Review, your subscription to the new magazine will begin with five months before renewal time.

### **How much will the new magazine cost? Will there still be group subscriptions?**

The cost of the new magazine is still to be determined. If you are part of a group subscription to The Mennonite, you can maintain your group going forward.

### **How will renewals to the new magazine happen?**

We are rebuilding our online subscription renewal system so that it works better than the current one. In addition to the online renewal option, subscribers will still be able to renew by mail.
